
Psychology Research Centre

Attendance

The students are required to have at least 75% attendance (including practical and internship) in the academic session, students failing to have it they will not be permitted to appear at the Annual / Final Examination.

2nd Year

As per NCTE norms, a candidate should have secured at least 50% marks in aggregate of B.A./B.Sc./B.Com. Degree/or equivalent Examination or Master degree from any recognized university.

A relaxation of 5% is granted to the candidate belonging to reserved categories namely SC, ST.

Intake

Only 100 students will be admitted in two academic year.

How to apply

Prospectus and Application forms and other details can be availed from the college office on payment of Rs. 1000/- cash or 1050/- through DD favour of Seemanchal Minority B.Ed. college payable at Katihar. It may also be downloaded from the college website; in such case the applicant must make the applicable payment at the time of submission of the form.

Admission Procedure

Qualifying in entrance test is must.

Admission will be taken on the basis of academic qualification and personal interview. In case of non-availability of candidates under reservation category, vacant seats will be filled with UR and OBC category candidates.

Field Works Experience

Practice Teaching will be organized on School Working days, Feed Back - practice through micro teaching practice.

Observation by peers will be arranged by the Department of Education.


